

DMOTC AGILITY COURSE TEST (ACT) 1 & 2 on Wednesday, May 15, 2019 at 6:30pm.

The Agility Course Test (ACT) is an entry-level agility event to introduce beginning dogs and handlers to the sport of agility and the AKC agility program. Dogs may be entered at ANY of the following jump height divisions: 4, 8, 12, 16, 20 or 24 inches. There is no Regular or Preferred distinction in the ACT program, and a measurement and/or jump height card is not required to enter an ACT event.

- Entry Fee(s): \$10.00 for each run.
- Classes Offered: ACT 1 and ACT 2 (Two Rounds of Each)
- Entry Limit: 60 total runs per day
- Entry Method(s): First Received (mail and hand delivery accepted.)
- Opening Date for Pre-Entries: April 22, 2019 at 8am
- Closing Date for Pre-Entries: May 13, 2019 at 8pm
- "Day of" entries will be accepted provided entry limit has not been reached.
- DMOTC Building Hours: 6:00 pm – 9:00 pm
- ACT Evaluators: Sherry Bennett, Karri Higgins and Helena Lloyd
- Check In/Volunteer Sign Up Will Begin at 6:00 pm
- Briefing/Walkthroughs Will Begin at 6:30 pm. Plan on arriving no later than 6:15 so you have time to exercise your dog, set up your crate and be in the ring for the briefing at 6:30.

Running Order/Jump Heights:

ACT 1 – Round 1: 4, 8, 12, 16, 20, 24
Round 2: 24, 20, 16, 12, 8, 4

ACT 2 – Round 1: 4, 8, 12, 16, 20, 24
Round 2: 24, 20, 16, 12, 8, 4

(Entries for the ACT 2 tests will also be accepted following the ACT 1 tests if the entry limit has not already been reached.)

Other Important Info:

All dogs must be on a short leash in the building (no flexis) and/or securely crated when not in the ring. At the handler's option, dogs may run a course with or without an approved collar. The only collars allowed when running a course are flat buckle or rolled leather collars, with no attachments (tags or other) allowed.

Bring a crate with you (and a mat or sheet to go under your crate) so your dog has a place to relax while you walk the course (dogs are not allowed on course during walk-thru). If you don't have a crate, please bring someone with you to hold your dog. Bring a copy of your AKC registration if you have one. AKC registration is required to receive the ACT 1 and ACT 2 titles from the AKC, but it is NOT required to participate in the event. Dogs who do not have AKC registration paperwork are still eligible to compete. Details on alternative registration will be covered at the event. Remember - this is an opportunity to learn how you can compete further in AKC events if you choose! Either way, qualifying certificates and/or ribbons will be awarded.

In order to acquire the title certificate and have the title added to a dog's record, the dog must be registered/listed with the AKC. Canine Partner applications may be accepted at the test by the judge/evaluator and submitted with test results. Dogs that are not AKC registered/listed may participate and their performance will be recorded by the AKC under a temporary recording number. This temporary recording number will be e-mailed to the owner and must be used when entering subsequent ACT events and when the owner registers/lists the dog. (Note: Temporary recording numbers may only be used to enter ACT events.)

A dog must receive two qualifying scores in ACT1 to receive the ACT1 title, and two qualifying scores in ACT2 to receive the ACT2 title. A dog does not need to have the ACT1 titles in order to compete in ACT2. If your dog already has the ACT1 title, you may not enter that dog in ACT1 again. Once you have an ACT 2 title (if you skipped Act1) you may not go back and enter ACT1. You can show in ACT2 until you get a Novice agility title.

All applicable regulations in Regulations for Agility Trials will govern the conduct of ACT events. They will apply to any person and dog entered. For more information, see: <http://images.akc.org/pdf/rulebooks/REAGIL.pdf>. All dogs fifteen (15) months of age or older may enter provided they have not earned any AKC Agility Titles. Dogs must be physically sound as described in Chapter 1, Section 3, Paragraph 7 of the Regulations for Agility Trials.

In consideration of the acceptance of this entry, I (we) agree to abide by the rules and regulations of The American Kennel Club in effect at the time of this event, and any additional rules and regulations published for this event and any decision made in accord with them and further agree to be bound by this Agreement. I (we) agree that the club or ACT Evaluator, holding this event has the right to refuse this entry for cause which the club or ACT Evaluator shall deem sufficient. I (we) certify and represent that the dog entered is not a hazard to persons or other dogs. In consideration of the acceptance of this entry and of the holding of this event and of the opportunity to have the dog judged and to win prizes, ribbons, or trophies, I (we) agree to hold the AKC, the event-giving club, their members, directors, governors, officers, agents, superintendents, event secretary and the owner and/or lessor of the premises and any provider of services that are necessary to hold this event and any employees or volunteers of the aforementioned parties, and any AKC approved judge or ACT Evaluator, judging at this event, harmless from any claim for loss or injury which may be alleged to have been caused directly or indirectly to any person or thing by the act of this dog while in or about the event premises or grounds or near any entrance thereto, and I (we) personally assume all responsibility and liability for any such claim; and I (we) further agree to hold the aforementioned parties harmless from any claim for loss, injury or damage to this dog. INSTRUCTIONS

Dogs may be entered in any jump height. There is no Regular or Preferred distinction at AKC's ACT events.

In order to acquire the ACT1 or ACT2 title certificate and have the title added to a dog's record, the dog must be registered/listed with the American Kennel Club. AKC Canine PartnersSM applications may be accepted at the event and submitted to AKC with the event's results.

Dogs that are not AKC registered/listed may be registered at a later date and receive their ACT title at that time.

Dogs listed in the AKC Canine PartnersSM program should be listed as All American Dog and must include their AKC number on the entry form and check the AKC No. box.

Junior Handlers should enter their Junior Handler Number on the front of this form. Should you not have your Junior Handler number, it may be obtained from the American Kennel Club (919) 233-9767. If the Junior Handler is not the owner of the dog identified on the face of this form, what is the relationship of the Junior Handler to the Owner?
