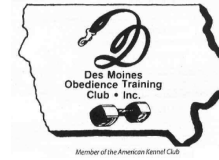

AGREEMENT

I (we) agree that the club holding this event has the right to refuse this entry for cause which the club shall deem sufficient. In consideration of the acceptance of this entry and of the holding of this event and of the opportunity to have the dog judged and to win prizes, ribbons, or trophies, I (we) agree to hold the AKC, the event-giving club, their members, directors, governors, officers, agents, superintendents or event secretary and the owner and/or lessor of the premises and any provider of services that are necessary to hold this event and any employees or volunteers of the aforementioned parties, and any AKC approved judge, judging at this event harmless from any claim for loss or injury which may be alleged to have been caused directly or indirectly to any person or thing by the act of this dog while in or about the event premises or grounds or near any entrance thereto, and I (we) personally assume all responsibility and liability for any such claim, and I (we) further agree to hold the aforementioned parties harmless from any claim for loss, injury or damage to this dog.

Additionally, I (we) hereby assume the sole responsibility for and agree to indemnify, defend and save the aforementioned parties harmless from any and all loss and expense (including legal fees) by reason of the liability imposed by law upon any of the aforementioned parties for damage because of bodily injuries, including death at any time resulting there from sustained by any person or persons, including myself (ourselves), or on account of damage to property, arising out of or in consequence of my (our) participation in this event, however such, injuries, death or property damage may be caused, and whether or not the same may have been caused or may be alleged to have been caused by the negligence of the aforementioned parties or any of their employees, agents, or any other persons. INSTRUCTIONS

1. (Variety) if you are entering a dog of breed in which there are varieties for show purposes, please designate the particular variety you are entering, i.e. Cocker Spaniel (solid color black, ASCOB, parti-color), Beagles (not exceeding 11 in., over 11 in. but not exceeding 15 in.), Dachshunds (longhaired, smooth, wirehaired), Collies (rough, smooth), Bull Terriers (colored, white), Manchester Terriers (standard, toy), Chihuahuas (smooth coat, long coat), English Toy Spaniels (King Charles and Ruby, Blenheim and Prince Charles), Poodles (toy, miniature, standard).

2. The following categories of dogs may be entered and shown in Best of Breed competition: Dogs that are Champions of Record and dogs which, according to their owners records, have completed the requirements for a championship, but whose championships are unconfirmed. The showing of unconfirmed Champions in Best of Breed competition is limited to a period of 90 days from the date of the show where the dog completed the requirements for a championship.

3. (Event Class) Consult the classification in this premium list. If the event class in which you are entering your dog is divided, then, in addition to designating the class, specify the particular division of the class in which you are entering your dog, i.e. age division, color division, weight division.

4. A dog must be entered in the name of the person who actually owned it at the time entries for an event closed. If a registered dog has been acquired by a new owner it must be entered in the name of its new owner in any event for which entries closed after the date of acquirement, regardless of whether the new owner has received the registration certificate indicating that the dog is recorded in his name. State on entry form whether transfer application has been mailed to the AKC. (For complete rules, refer to Chapter 11, Section 3.)

Attention Exhibitors

Bitches in Season will be allowed to participate subject to the conditions set forth in Chapter 2, Section 8 of the Tracking Regulations.

Test Worker Options: One (1) TDX track will be reserved for test workers who have worked both days of a DMOTC tracking test within the last 2 years. If necessary, a random drawing may be held to determine which test worker is chosen. The remaining workers will automatically be included in the drawing with all other tracking entries received. Worker(s) must notify the test secretary in writing of intent to be considered for the worker track.

Drawing: The procedures specified in Chapter 1, Section 11, of the Tracking Regulations, shall be observed. A drawing of the entries and assignments of position on the alternate lists will be held at the 31474 Cedar Creek Trail, Woodward, IA 50276 on Oct 7, 2021 at 7PM. The Test Secretary will attempt to contact all entrants of the draw results within 48 hours of the drawing and sending the Judging Program by email no less than seven (7) days prior to the test. You may email the Test Secretary after the draw.

Certification for TD Test: With the entry form for a dog which has not passed an AKC Tracking Test, there must be accompanying a written statement, by a person who is accredited by the AKC to judge a Tracking Test, that the dog is considered by a judge to be ready for such a Test. This statement must be dated within twelve (11) months of the date of the test.

An exhibitor may enter more than one dog. The holding of other titles including "TD", "VST" or "TDX" shall not bar a dog from competition in the tests. Dogs without a "TD" or "TDX" will be accepted first.

An Alternate list will be maintained. Entry Fees will be refunded to alternates who decline to be placed on the Alternate List. Also, entry fees will be refunded to alternates who do not participate in the Test. Entry fees will NOT be refunded to a scheduled entrant who is absent on the day of the Test unless an alternate is present and runs in place of the absent dog.

Risk: The Owner or agent entering a dog in a Tracking Test does so at his/her own risk and agrees to abide all the Rules and Regulations of the American Kennel Club. The Des Moines Obedience Training Club assumes no responsibility for any personal property, theft, injury, or death of any animal or loss of or damage to any property while at this Test, or the Test site, or in transit to or from the site.

Disaster and Emergency Preparedness Plan: The DMOTC has prepared such a plan for this event and it is available to ALL participants upon request, and will be available at the Test Site.

Facilities: "Long House" Shelter at Chichaqua. Breakfast items will be available before the draw.

Directions to the site: I35 from the north or south. Take Exit 96 (Elkhart/Polk City) which is NE 116th Ave (Hwy 22) to the east. Turn left onto NE 72nd St, take the first right on to NE 80th St and follow NE 80th to the Long House Shelter on your left. Near the campground.
